**Greater Springfield**—The families and communities we serve are always our top priority. Safety is a top priority and we will modify our operations per guidance as guidelines are extended or updated from CDC and Illinois IDPH.

Illinois is now in Phase 5 of “Restore Illinois.” Illinois is “open” and the key points are the following:

1. Fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask except where required by federal, state, local, including local business and workplace guidance.
2. Masking is recommended for unvaccinated persons and required for all people while traveling on public transportation, in congregate settings, in health care settings, as well as in schools, day cares, and educational institutions pursuant to the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) and CDC guidance.
3. Businesses and local municipalities can still put in place additional mitigations as they deem appropriate.
4. Illinois continues to recommend face coverings for unvaccinated persons, as well as all individuals while in congregate facilities such as correctional facilities, veterans’ homes, and long-term care facilities, group homes, and residential facilities.

Our services and facilities are currently fully available in the communities we serve, and our organization will continue to follow the guidance provided by the State of Illinois.
